CONTRACT AGREEMENT

JUL 21 2022

THIS AGREEMENT made on the ____ day of _____ 2022 between **MOUNTAIN PROVINCE STATE POLYTECHNIC COLLEGE** (hereinafter called the "Entity") and **ASPEN MULTI SYSTEM CORPORATION** (hereinafter called the "Supplier").

WHEREAS, the **MOUNTAIN PROVINCE STATE POLYTECHNIC COLLEGE** invited bids for specific goods under the project title "**SUPPLY AND DELIVERY OF NURSING LABORATORY EQUIPMENT**" and has accepted a Bid by the Supplier in the amount of **EIGHT MILLION FOUR HUNDRED NINETY-SEVEN THOUSAND PESOS AND NINETY-SIX CENTAVOS (P8,497,000.96)** (hereinafter called "the Contract Price").

NOW THIS AGREEMENT WITNESSETH AS FOLLOWS:

1. In this Agreement words and expressions shall have the same meanings as are respectively assigned to them in the Conditions of Contract referred to.
2. The following documents as required by the 2016 revised Implementing Rules and Regulations of Republic Act No. 9184 shall be deemed to form and be read and construed as integral part of this Agreement, viz.:

- i. Philippine Bidding Documents (PBDs);
 - i. Schedule of Requirements;
 - ii. Technical Specifications;
 - iii. General and Special Conditions of Contract; and
 - iv. Supplemental or Bid Bulletins, if any
- ii. Winning bidder's bid, including the Eligibility requirements, Technical and Financial Proposals, and all other documents or statements submitted;

Bid form, including all the documents/statements contained in the Bidder's bidding envelopes, as annexes, and all other documents submitted (e.g., Bidder's response to request for clarifications on the bid), including corrections to the bid, if any, resulting from the Procuring Entity's bid evaluation;

- iii. Performance Security;
- iv. Notice of Award of Contract; and the Bidder's conforme thereto; and
- v. Other contract documents that may be required by existing laws and/or the Procuring Entity concerned in the PBDs. Winning bidder agrees that additional contract documents or information prescribed by the GPPB that are subsequently required for submission after the contract execution, such as the Notice to Proceed, Variation Orders, and Warranty Security, shall likewise form part of the Contract.

3. In consideration for the sum of **EIGHT MILLION FOUR HUNDRED NINETY-SEVEN THOUSAND PESOS AND NINETY-SIX CENTAVOS (P8,497,000.96)** or such other sums as may be ascertained, **ASPEN MULTI SYSTEM CORPORATION** agrees to execute the contract **"SUPPLY AND DELIVERY OF NURSING LABORATORY EQUIPMENT"** in accordance with his/her/its Bid.
4. **ASPEN MULTI-SYSTEM CORPORATION** binds itself in behalf of the Entity to enable the performance of all legally enforceable warranty on the item and its accessory components, expressed and implied, as provided by the manufacturer within the period officially set under the terms and conditions covering the warranty;
5. The **MOUNTAIN PROVINCE STATE POLYTECHNIC COLLEGE** agrees to pay the above-mentioned sum in accordance with the terms of the Bidding.
