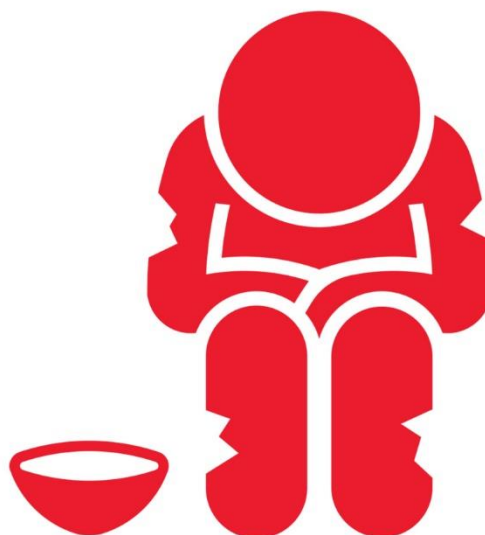

According to data from the Philippine Statistics Authority, the poverty rate in Mountain Province for the year 2022 is high, with 23 out of every 100 families experiencing poverty. This province is also home to one of the marginalized sectors in our society, the Indigenous Peoples. Poverty and education are inextricably linked. University anti-poverty programmes



The College set admission goals for students in the lowest 20% of household income, established graduation targets for this group, and implemented programs to support their college completion, including assistance with essential and basic needs as food, housing, transportation and legal services.

Community anti-poverty programmes



MPSPC offers support to local entrepreneurs by providing relevant education and resources for financially and socially sustainable businesses, including mentorship programs, training workshops and access to university facilities. Additionally, it provides support to boost the start-up of such businesses in the local community.
